P and C Christmas Raffle

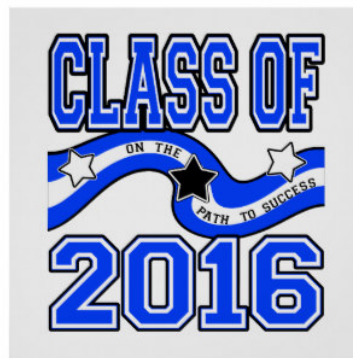
