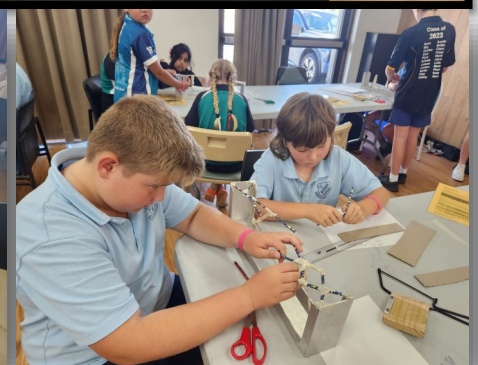




2023 CHAMPION SCHOOL

The Science and Engineering Challenge (SEC) is a nationwide Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) outreach program presented by the University of Newcastle in partnership with communities, Rotary clubs, universities and other sponsors. Through the SEC, students experience aspects of science and engineering which they would not usually see in their school environment. Western Plains Science and Engineering Challenge is conducted by combined Rotary clubs of Dubbo and surrounding district and is an annual four-day event in which secondary school and primary school students compete in Dubbo. The Challenge has been conducted in Dubbo every year since it began in 2000. 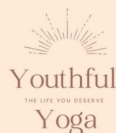
