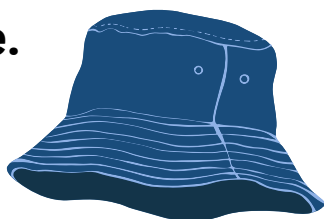

Recently, we had the great pleasure of hosting Moorambilla Voices for a music workshop as part of their 2024 Skills Development Tour. Moorambilla Voices is a nationally-awarded program that seeks to give regional students an opportunity to sing, dance and create incredible performances and tours across Australia.

Over February and March, Moorambilla will deliver workshops across regional NSW to over 3,200 children in Years 3-12, from Goodooga to Molong, Wilcannia to Wee Waa and everywhere in between. During the recent workshop, our students engaged with Artistic Director Michelle Leonard OAM, learning about music through fun, collaborative and creative activities. Some students will be invited to join Moorambilla for their August and September Residency Camps in Baradine where they will create works which connect to their community and the landscape with world-class musicians, performers, composers, choreographers and visual artists.
